RESEARCH PROGRAMS LEADERSHIP AND CO-LEADERSHIP

Since my PhD doctoral research on the Nile delta process of urbanization, I have set up several research projects on various deltas dynamics of population and environmental vulnerability (Nile, Niger, Red River, Bengal) deltas.

My research activities focus on three issues: the forms and dynamics of subaltern urbanization processes in densely populated Asia linked to urban-rural relations (migration, waste recycling); the vulnerability of populations in the densely populated deltas of Asia (Mekong and Ganges-Brahmapoutre-Meghna) and adaptation strategies to climate change, including environmental migration; coastal and deltaic cities facing climate and environmental changes.

I have been managing numerous research projects on the field with my Vietnamese partners for 17 years on issues related to migration, industrialization and urbanization in the highly dense and vulnerable Red River Delta. I lived 7 years in Hanoi (2003-2010) and since every year I spend one or two months in Vietnam with my partners to carry on our on going projects.

Since 2014, I have organized various events in Hanoi and HCMC to set up a large network of researchers in Asia addressing the issues of densification, urbanization and migration in the framework of the Observatory of the population densification in Asia. We are collecting statistical data bases and maps on the Mekong, Red River and Bengal deltas dynamics of population from various projects to feed our researches on the densification of the population, the land use changes and the environmental degradation.

In 2016, I have started a new field of research in India (West Bengal) and Bangladesh thanks to the participation to the Collaborative Research BandAid project– **Bangladesh Delta: Assessment of the Causes of Sea-level Rise Hazards and Integrated Development of Predictive Modelinlg Towards Mitigation and Adaptation** funded by Belmont Forum. This has been a great opportunity for me to work with physical scientists on environmental issues and their links with climate change and migration.
